3. What was the problem with their intermarriage?
4. What should be some concerns today with a believer marrying an unbeliever?  
(Ezra 9:1-4; 2 Cor 6:14)
5. What is God’s response to unbelief? (v 3)
6. “Nephilim” is translated as “fallen ones.” Are they angels or men?
7. How is 6:5 a description of our sinful nature and total depravity?
8. God is spirit, yet shows emotion as we do. What is his emotion here?
9. Did Noah in any way earn God’s favor?

15. How big was the ark?

16. What are the stipulations of God's covenant with Noah?
