4. How was Moses and Jesus faithful to God in their own ways? (vs 5-6)

5. Who is the real builder of the house, and what is the house of God?

Part 2: Heb 3:7-19, “Hear and Believe”

6. What is the setting for v 7-11? Read Numbers 14:1-38.

7. What does the author warn us about the consequences of sin? How should this caution us in our own lives?

8. Is this something that could be taken care of in the future?

9. What is the correlation being drawn in v 16-19?

15. How does the author of the Hebrews speak of the Word of God?

Part 4: Heb 4:14-16, “Jesus the Great High Priest”

16. What is the encouragement given in verse 14? How does this remind us of Heb 3:1?

17. What comfort do we have in our temptations?
