Lesson 9: Hebrews 9, "The Blood of Christ Purifies Your Conscience"

Part 1: Hebrews 9:1-10, "Recalling the Old Ways of Worship"

1. How does verse 1 imply that there are regulations for worship in the Early Church and even for our time?
2. What is the author of the Hebrews recalling for his hearers? What is the significance of each of these items?
3. The first section "is symbolic for the present age" (v. 9). What is the Holy of Holies symbolic for? How did the OT believers only have a glimpse of this?
4. How were the sacrifices of the OT primarily for the bodily regulations?
5. What is the "time of reformation"?

Part 2: Hebrews 9:11-14, "Christ Secures Our Eternal Redemption"

6. How was Christ both our high priest and sacrifice? (v. 12)
7. If the OT sacrifices only purified the flesh, what does Christ's blood do for us?
8. How does this blood benefit us, not just once in time, but even today?
