7. What does he mean by “leaders”? (v. 7 and 17)

8. Where else is the theme of imitation mentioned? (Phil. 4:9; 1 Thess. 1:6) Is this an imitation of works?

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9. What does v 8 mean for our doctrine and Scriptures?

10. How can complacency lead us to “diverse and strange teachings”?
