I. Romans 8:18-25

1. What comfort helps the Christian endure suffering?
2. What waits along with the Christian for the time when full sonship will be revealed?

5. What is some of the evidence in the world that creation groans?
6. What is the "redemption of our bodies"?
7. What then is the hope that we have?

II. Romans 8:26-30

8. How does the Holy Spirit intercede for us? Who does the same (v 34)
9. What is the good that God is working together for the believer in verse 28?

10. Paul here speaks of the election to salvation of those who are in Christ. Who does he not talk about in this passage? Why or why not?

11. How is God working our predestination out?

III. Romans 8:31-39

12. How do we know that God is for us?

13. However who would lay a charge against God's elect?

14. Why is there no longer a successful charge against us? (v 33-34)

15. How does verse 33 connection election with justification?

16. What might cause us to think that we are separated from the love of Christ? (v 36)

17. Of what can the Christian be assured and take comfort? (v 39)

Romans 8:38-39, "For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."
