TEXT: Chapter 9:



27 And Isaiah cries out concerning Israel: “Though the number of the sons of Israel be as the sand of the sea, only a remnant of them will be saved, 28 for **the Lord** will carry out his sentence upon the earth fully and without delay.” 29 And as Isaiah predicted,

“If the **Lord of hosts** had not left us offspring, we would have been like Sodom and become like Gomorrah.”

30 What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith; 31 but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law. 32 Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over **the stumbling stone**, 33 as it is written,

“Behold, **I am** laying in Zion **a stone** of stumbling, and **a rock** of offense; and whoever believes in **him** will not be put to shame.

STUDY NOTES:

D. THE MOLDER AND THE E. THE REMNANT 27 And Isaiah cries out concerning Israel: “Though the number of the sons of Israel be as the sand of the sea, only a remnant of them will be saved, 28 for **the Lord** will carry out his sentence upon the earth fully and without delay.” (**Is 10:22,23**) 29 And as Isaiah predicted, “If the **Lord of hosts** had not left us offspring, we would have been like Sodom and become like Gomorrah.” (**Is 1:9**)

F. RIGHEOUSNESS IS BY FAITH IN JESUS THE ROCK– NOT BY WORKS 30 What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith; 31 but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law. 32 Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over the stumbling stone, 33 as it is written, “Behold, I am laying in Zion **a stone** of stumbling, and **a rock** of offense; and whoever believes in **him** will not be put to shame.”
